



NEIGHBOURHOOD VIBE

A charming mix of small-town and urban living, with a cottagey feel and waterfront amenities.

WHAT YOU'LL LOVE

Access to the waterfront trail system, parks with playgrounds and sports facilities, and great schools.

This neighbourhood has a consistent population, and is popular with families with kids under 5, families with kids aged 5 to 9, families with teens, people in their 40s, and people in their 50s. The Bronte neighbourhood is in southwest Oakville, with the shore of Lake Ontario as its southern boundary. Bronte was established in 1834, and was a commercial shipping centre for grain and timber, and later became a commercial fishing port, with its two harbours. Bronte is an access point for the waterfront trail system, and it has a waterfront park with a beach, lighthouse, play and picnic areas, pier, and boardwalk. The area has both a small-town, cottagey feel and urban dining and other amenities. Some housing is older, in cottage styles, but there are also new developments of condo highrises, as well as newer single- and semi-detached homes.

People & Families in Bronte East

Families with kids make up 51% of households in this neighbourhood, while couples without children make up 26% of households and 17% of households are one person living alone. People in this neighbourhood come from 99 different ethnic origins, and 35% are first–generation immigrants, while 28% are second–generation immigrants.

Having Fun in Bronte East

Fun is easy to find at the many parks & rec facilities here. Parks in this neighbourhood feature playgrounds for kids, sports parks, and skating. There are 12 parks in this neighbourhood, with 49 recreational facilities in total. The average number of facilities per park is 4.
